URGES

The European Union so that, in agreement with NATO and the United States, it can strive to reach the end of fighting and a global agreement on security in Europe;

REMINDS

- that each war represents a defeat, a failure of Mankind and that everything must be done to avoid war between Nations and Peoples;

CONSIDERS, WITH ABSOLUTE CONVICTION

- That it is necessary to summon the whole world, peacefully, to ask for the establishment of diplomatic solutions that can lead to the prompt cessation of violations of Human Rights and of International Law.
